

# Keyboard (□□□□□□)

A **Keyboard** is the most commonly used **input device** of a computer. It is used to enter **text, numbers, symbols, and commands** into the computer. Almost every desktop, laptop, and many other digital devices use a keyboard for user interaction.

A keyboard acts as a communication bridge between the **user** and the **computer**. Whenever a key is pressed, the keyboard sends the corresponding signal to the CPU, which processes the input and displays the result on the monitor.

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## Important Note (□□□□□□□□ □□□□ )

- **Keyboard is an Input Device.**
- **The standard keyboard layout is QWERTY.**
- **Keyboard sends data to the CPU in the form of binary signals.**
